Slips, Trips and Falls

... a major cause of injuries for Nova Scotia workers



Average benefit payments for time-loss claim due to a work-related slip, trip or fall injury in 2016







Average days lost from work due to a slip, trip or fall injury

Primary contributing factors for slip, trips and falls:

- Ice+snow
- Water+liquid
- Getting in/out of vehicle
- Going up/down steps and stairs



Fall from 16' to concrete in 2016: Claim cost =

\$210,000 and counting

Fall through ceiling in 2016: Claim cost =

\$68,000°



Did you know?

An unrestrained adult fall from standing has been shown to produce 12x's more force than what is required to cause a simple skull fracture.2
