Average days lost from work

due to a slip, trip, fall injury<sup>1</sup>

Primary contributing factors for slip, trips, falls:

- Ice+snow
- Water+liquid
- Getting in/out of vehicle
- Going up/down steps and stairs

2019 claims resulting from a slip, trip or fall on ice totalled

in benefit payments and

in lost days from work.



## Did you know?

An unrestrained adult fall from standing has been shown to produce 12x's more force than what is required to cause a simple skull fracture.2
