Assessment Criteria: Responses

Please respond to the criteria in the field provided. Please keep your responses brief – generally allow about a half single-spaced page (250 words) for each.

1. What were the individual's health and safety achievements/contributions, and how were they accomplished?

2. What barriers to success, if any, were encountered - and how were they overcome?

3. How were the improvements in health and safety performance measured?

4. In what way was the individual's approach and contribution integral in achieving better OHS performance within the organization?

5. Describe how the individual's impact on health and safety management and performance was above and beyond their immediate field/area of responsibility.

6. What is the potential for the individual's contribution to have broader application to the organization, to the industry or beyond?

Nomination **must** also include:

- A letter from the employer supporting this nomination
- Objective evidence to validate stated accomplishments

Application may include supporting letters from colleagues and/or any other information/materials that may be relevant (photos, etc).

Award finalists **may** be visited by members of the judging panel to verify claims made in the proposals and gain further context.
