Primary contributing factors for slip, trips, falls:

- Water+liquid
- Getting in/out of vehicle
- Going up/down steps and stairs

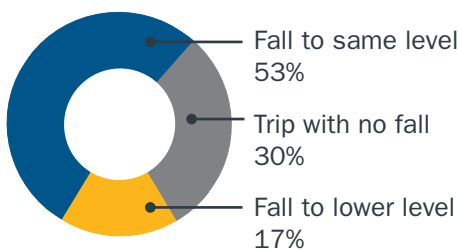
